Re: Declaration of Mild Drought Conditions

Dear Wholesale Water Customer:

The City of Corsicana has been notified the Trinity River Authority is initiating Stage 1 Drought Contingency Measures. These measures are in response to the current storage conditions in Navarro Mills Reservoir. Trinity River Authority has advised Stage 1 of the Plan may be rescinded when the conditions listed as triggering events have ceased to exist for a period of 15 consecutive days.

The City of Corsicana will enact the **Mild Drought Trigger Conditions** defined in Corsicana's Drought Contingency Plan, last updated in 2019. The City of Corsicana conditions will remain in effect and coincide with Trinity River Authority's measures.
